All the participants will be invited to present their pencil art in Microsoft teams for 2 minutes each before the judges on 26 June, 4:00 PM and the best concept pencil art will be selected for the award by the judges during the online contest which will be conducted via Microsoft Team. The best participant will be provided with the “Amrita Best Pencil Artist Award 2021 Certificate.”



Rules and Guidelines

- 1) This event is open to all UG and PG students at Amrita College of Engineering and Technology.
- 2) Online registration is mandatory. The last date for registration is 23.05.2021, 5.00 PM.
- 3) Creativity and Originality of the depicted theme is very essential.
- 4) The participants should submit their performance in the link provided after registration on or before 26.05.2021, 2:00 PM and be ready for the Teams Presentation
- 5) Submission of one entry is permitted for a participant.
- 6) The contestant will not be allowed to use other coloured paints rather than graphite pencils.
- 7) Any violation of the rules & regulations shall cause the cancellation of the candidature from the competition.
- 8) The decision of the jury will be final.
- 9) Results will be announced during the Institution Day Event.
